

AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS PROPOSED

The following amendments to by-laws is proposed by Council and are awaiting public comments. The main by-laws can be found under by-laws on our website.

(a) By-Law relating to the keeping of dogs

PREAMBLE

Whereas section 156(2) and (5) of the Constitution provides that a municipality may make and administer by-laws for the effective administration of the matters which it has the right to administer, and to exercise any power concerning a matter reasonably necessary for, or incidental to, the effective performance of its functions;

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists licensing of dogs and the control of public nuisances as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate the keeping of dogs and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

Also inserting Section 19 to read:

COMMENCEMENT

This by-law will come into operation on the date that the amendment By-Law is promulgated.

(b) By-Law relating to the keeping of poultry

PREAMBLE

Whereas section 156(2) and (5) of the Constitution provides that a municipality may make and administer by-laws for the effective administration of the matters which it has the right to administer, and to exercise any power concerning a matter reasonably necessary for, or incidental to, the effective performance of its functions;

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists the control of public nuisances as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate the keeping poultry and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

c) By-Law relating to advertising signs and the frontage of streets

PREAMBLE

Whereas section 156(2) and (5) of the Constitution provides that a municipality may make and administer by-laws for the effective administration of the matters which it has the right to administer, and to exercise any power concerning a matter reasonably necessary for, or incidental to, the effective performance of its functions;

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists the control billboards and the display of advertisements in public places as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate the display of billboards and advertisements in public places and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

d) By-Law relating to the control of cemeteries

PREAMBLE

Whereas section 156(2) and (5) of the Constitution provides that a municipality may make and administer by-laws for the effective administration of the matters which it has the right to administer, and to exercise any power concerning a matter reasonably necessary for, or incidental to, the effective performance of its functions;

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists the control of cemeteries, funeral parlours and crematoria as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate cemeteries, funeral parlours and crematoria and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

e) By-Law relating to fire safety

PREAMBLE

Whereas section 156(2) and (5) of the Constitution provides that a municipality may make and administer by-laws for the effective administration of the matters which it has the right to administer, and to exercise any power concerning a matter reasonably necessary for, or incidental to, the effective performance of its functions;

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists fire fighting services as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate fire safety and any matters connected therewith in their jurisdiction;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

f) Electricity supply by-law

PREAMBLE

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists electricity and gas reticulation as well as street lighting as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate electricity supply and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

g) By-Law relating to camping areas

PREAMBLE

any power concerning a matter reasonably necessary for, or incidental to, the effective performance of its functions;

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists municipal parks and recreation as well as local amenities as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate camping areas and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

h) By-Law relating to the prevention of nuisances

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists the control of public nuisances as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate the control of public nuisances and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists local amenities as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate local amenities and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

j) By-Law relating to parks for caravans and mobile homes

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists public places and local amenities, municipal parks and recreation as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate parks for caravans and mobile homes and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

k) By-Law relating to the control of disposal sites

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists refuse removal, refuse dumps and solid waste disposal as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate the control of disposal sites and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

l) By-Law relating to streets

PREAMBLE

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists municipal roads, street lighting and street trading as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate municipal roads, and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

m) Refuse Removal and Disposal

PREAMBLE

Whereas section 156(2) and (5) of the Constitution provides that a municipality may make and administer by-laws for the effective administration of the matters which it has the right to administer,

and to exercise any power concerning a matter reasonably necessary for, or incidental to, the effective performance of its functions;

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists refuse removal, refuse dumps and solid waste disposal as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate refuse removal, and disposal and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

This by-law will come into operation on the date that the amendment By-Law is promulgated.

n) **By-Law relating to water supply, sanitation services and industrial effluent**

PREAMBLE

Whereas section 156(2) and (5) of the Constitution provides that a municipality may make and administer by-laws for the effective administration of the matters which it has the right to administer, and to exercise any power concerning a matter reasonably necessary for, or incidental to, the effective performance of its functions;

AND WEHEREAS part B of Schedule 4 to the Constitution lists water and sanitation services limited to potable water supply systems and domestic waste-water and sewage disposal systems as local government matters to the extent set out in section 155(6) (a) and (7);

AND WHEREAS the Prince Albert Municipality seeks to manage, control and regulate water supply, sanitation services and industrial effluent and any matters connected therewith;

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Prince Albert Municipality as follows:-----

Also inserting Section 76 to read:

COMMENCEMENT

This by-law will come into operation on the date that the amendment By-Law is promulgated.
